2010 ANNUAL MEDICAL-LEGAL SEMINAR

INTRODUCTION:

The new CMS Mandatory Reporting Requirements, designed to enforce the Medicare Secondary Payer Act, go into full effect in 2010. These mandatory reporting rules create numerous issues and pitfalls related to the settlement of medical liability claims involving Medicare recipients. These new rules raise potential problems for healthcare providers and malpractice attorneys alike. This program will assist both in identifying and avoiding these potential pitfalls.

This program will also discuss drug seeking behavior in the Emergency Department and beyond, physician drug prescription and licensing issues, how to effectively terminate a difficult (or drug seeking) patient, and concludes with a review of significant Ohio case law decisions over the past year and a question and answer session with our panel of speakers.
